<u>C-Monitor (Mac) OS X client</u> [4] - client software (agent) for installation on computers with (Mac) OS X

<u>Communication between the CM Server and C-Monitor</u> **[5]** - basic information how the client communicates with the server

<u>Sending of notification messages from C-Monitor</u> [6] - information how emails are sent directly from the C-Monitor client (separately from CM Server emails)

<u>HW a SW</u> **[7]**requirements **[7]** - overview of required HW with supported OS for C-Monitor clients and conditions for installation of separate CM Server.
